1A. Jesus _____ kingdom news

Matthew 9:35a (NIV) Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the good news of the kingdom ...

1B. Jesus _____ kingdom power

Matthew 9:35b (NIV) ... and healing every disease and sickness.

John 14:11-13 (NIV) Believe me when I say that I am in the Father and the Father is in me; or at least believe on the evidence of the miracles themselves. I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in me will do what I have been doing. He will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father. And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Son may bring glory to the Father.

Matthew 9:36 (NIV) When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.

2B. _____ the harvest

Matthew 9:37 (NIV) Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few.

Matthew 9:38 (NIV) Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field."
