Acts 1:8 (NIV) But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

Romans 2:5 (NIV) But because of your stubbornness and your unrepentant heart, you are storing up wrath against yourself for the day of God's wrath, when his righteous judgment will be revealed.

Romans 3:1-2 (NIV) What advantage, then, is there in being a Jew, or what value is there in circumcision? Much in every way! First of all, they have been entrusted with the very words of God.

Romans 3:3-4 (NIV) What if some did not have faith? Will their lack of faith nullify God's faithfulness? Not at all! Let God be true, and every man a liar. As it is written: "So that you may be proved right when you speak and prevail when you judge."

1B. Faithless Jews are under God's _____

Romans 3:5-6 (NIV) But if our unrighteousness brings out God's righteousness more clearly, what shall we say? That God is unjust in bringing his wrath on us? (I am using a human argument.) Certainly not! If that were so, how could God judge the world?

Romans 3:9 (NIV) What shall we conclude then? Are we any better? Not at all! We have already made the charge that Jews and Gentiles alike are all under sin.

- **Is righteous.** Romans 3:10 (NIV) As it is written: "There is no one righteous, not even one;"
- Seeks God. Romans 3:11 (NIV) there is no one who understands, no one who seeks God.
- Does good. Romans 3:12 (NIV) All have turned away, they have together become worthless; there is no one who does good, not even one.
- Fears God. Romans 3:18 (NIV) There is no fear of God before their eyes.

2B. is ...

- A sinner. Romans 3:14-16 (NIV) "Their mouths are full of cursing and bitterness." "Their feet are swift to shed blood; ruin and misery mark their ways,"
- Accountable to God. Romans 3:19 (NIV) Now we know that whatever the law says, it says to those who are under the law, so that every mouth may be silenced and the whole world held accountable to God.
- Conscious of sin. Romans 3:20 (NIV) Therefore no one will be declared righteous in his sight by observing the law; rather, through the law we become conscious of sin.

Matthew 25:46 (NIV) Then they [those on his left] will go away to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life.
