*Colossians 1:15-16 (NIV) He [Jesus] is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. For by him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things were created by him and for him.*

*Hebrews 2:14 (NIV) Since the children have flesh and blood, he too shared in their humanity so that by his death he might destroy him who holds the power of death--that is, the devil—*

*Hebrews 4:15 (NIV) For we do not have a high priest [Jesus] who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are--yet was without sin.*

*Hebrews 1:3a (NIV) The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word.*

*John 10:10 (NIV) The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.*

*1 John 3:5 (NIV) But you know that he [Jesus] appeared so that he might take away our sins. And in him is no sin.*

*1 John 4:9 (NIV) This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him.*

*Romans 5:10 (NLT) For since our friendship with God was restored by the death of his Son while we were still his enemies, we will certainly be saved through the life of his Son.*

*Romans 10:9 (NIV) That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.*
