Matthew 16:18 (NIV) ... I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it.

Matthew 28:18-20 (NIV) Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

#### 1. Release God's \_\_\_\_\_ through prayer

Matthew 28:18 (NIV) Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.

Acts 1:8 (NIV) But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

2 Timothy 3:5 (NIV) [In the last days there will be those] having a form of godliness but denying its power. Have nothing to do with them.

## 2. \_\_\_\_\_ and make disciples in St. Louis

Matthew 28:19 (NIV) Therefore go and make disciples of all nations,

Matthew 5:16 (NIV) ... Let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven.

Revelation 7:9 (NIV) After this I looked and there before me was a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, tribe, people and language, standing before the throne and in front of the Lamb.

#### 3. Build a \_\_\_\_\_ church family

Matthew 28:19 (NIV) ... baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

1 Corinthians 12:13 (NIV) For we were all baptized by one Spirit into one body--whether Jews or Greeks, slave or free--and we were all given the one Spirit to drink.

Acts 2:46 (NIV) Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts.

#### 4. Teach obedience to all of \_\_\_\_\_

Matthew 28:20a (NIV) and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you.

- 2 Timothy 3:16-17 (NIV) All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.
- 2 Timothy 4:3 (NIV) For the time will come when men will not put up with sound doctrine. Instead, to suit their own desires, they will gather around them a great number of teachers to say what their itching ears want to hear.

# 5. Live in God's \_\_\_\_\_

Matthew 28:20b (NIV) And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

1 Thessalonians 5:17-19 (NIV) pray continually; give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus. Do not put out the Spirit's fire;
