1 Peter 5:8 (NIV) Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.

Matthew 6:13 (NIV) And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.

1 Corinthians 10:13 (NIV) No temptation has seized you except what is common to man. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it.

1. Build your _____ with God

John 17:6a (NIV) I have revealed you to those whom you gave me out of the world.

1A. _____ God's Word

John 17:6b (NIV) They were yours; you gave them to me and they have obeyed your word.

1B. Live to _____ Jesus

John 17:9-10 (NIV) I pray for them. I am not praying for the world, but for those you have given me, for they are yours. ... And glory has come to me through them.

2. Rely on God's _____

John 17:11a (NIV) I will remain in the world no longer, but they are still in the world, and I am coming to you.

2A. Stay _____ with your church

John 17:11b (NIV) Holy Father, protect them by the power of your name--the name you gave me--so that they may be one as we are one.

2B. Keep separate from the _____ ways

John 17:14-15 (NIV) I have given them your word and the world has hated them, for they are not of the world any more than I am of the world. My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one.

3. Set yourself apart to _____ God

John 17:16-17a (NIV) They are not of the world, even as I am not of it. Sanctify them by the truth;

3A. Let the _____ of God's Word change you

John 17:17b (NIV) Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth.

3B. _____ others in the world about Jesus

John 17:18-19 (NIV) As you sent me into the world, I have sent them into the world. For them I sanctify myself, that they too may be truly sanctified.
