4. Coaching as...

Phase I: When willing, urge to tell Jesus they want to start:

- Trusting Him as FORGIVER.
- Trusting Him as FRIEND.
- Trusting Him as LEADER.

5. Phase II: Coach their new relationship

- Offer to meet weekly to encourage & coach them in their new partnership with Jesus.
