1 Samuel 1:10 (NIV) In her deep anguish Hannah prayed to the LORD, weeping bitterly.

1 Samuel 1:11 (NIV) And she made a vow, saying, "LORD Almighty, if you will only look on your servant's misery and remember me, and not forget your servant but give her a son, then I will give him to the LORD for all the days of his life, and no razor will ever be used on his head."

1 Samuel 1:18b (NIV) Then she went her way and ate something, and her face was no longer downcast.

3. Praying mothers receive God's _____

1 Samuel 1:19-20 (NIV) Early the next morning they arose and worshiped before the LORD and then went back to their home at Ramah. Elkanah made love to his wife Hannah, and the LORD remembered her. So in the course of time Hannah became pregnant and gave birth to a son. She named him Samuel, saying, "Because I asked the LORD for him."

4. Praying mothers ______ their children to God

1 Samuel 1:27-28 (NIV) I prayed for this child, and the LORD has granted me what I asked of him. So now I give him to the LORD. For his whole life he will be given over to the LORD." And he worshiped the LORD there.

Psalm 127:3 (NIV) Children are a heritage from the LORD, offspring a reward from him.

1 Samuel 2:1 (NIV) Then Hannah prayed and said: "My heart rejoices in the LORD; in the LORD my horn is lifted high. My mouth boasts over my enemies, for I delight in your deliverance.

1 Samuel 2:26 (NIV) And the boy Samuel continued to grow in stature and in favor with the LORD and with people.

1 Samuel 2:21a (NIV) And the LORD was gracious to Hannah; she gave birth to three sons and two daughters.
