Luke 19:10 (ESV) For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.

Psalm 42:1 (ESV) As a deer pants for flowing streams, so pants my soul for vou, O God.

Jeremiah 2:13 (ESV) for my people have committed two evils: they have forsaken me, the fountain of living waters, and hewed out cisterns for themselves, broken cisterns that can hold no water.

1. Jesus breaks

John 4:7 (ESV) A woman from Samaria came to draw water. Jesus said to her, "Give me a drink."

John 4:10 (ESV) Jesus answered her, "If you knew the gift of God, and who it is that is saving to you, 'Give me a drink,' you would have asked him, and he would have given you living water."

2. Jesus promises life

John 4:13-14 (ESV) Jesus said to her, "Everyone who drinks of this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks of the water that I will give him will never be thirsty again. The water that I will give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life."

John 4:15 (ESV) The woman said to him, "Sir, give me this water, so that I will not be thirsty or have to come here to draw water."

3. Jesus shows insight

John 4:16 (ESV) Jesus said to her, "Go, call your husband, and come here."

John 4:18 (ESV) for you have had five husbands, and the one you now have is not your husband. What you have said is true."

John 4:19 (ESV) The woman said to him, "Sir, I perceive that you are a prophet.

4. Jesus overcomes

John 4:20 (ESV) Our fathers worshiped on this mountain, but you say that in Jerusalem is the place where people ought to worship."

John 4:23-24 (ESV) But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship him. God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth."

5. Jesus reveals His _____

John 4:25 (ESV) The woman said to him, "I know that Messiah is coming (he who is called Christ). When he comes, he will tell us all things."

John 4:26 (ESV) Jesus said to her, "I who speak to you am he."

John 4:35 (ESV) Do you not say, 'There are yet four months, then comes the harvest'? Look, I tell you, lift up your eyes, and see that the fields are white for harvest.
