2 Corinthians 5:17 (ESV) Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.

John 4:23 (ESV) But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship him.

John 8:31-32 (ESV) So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed him, "If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

1. You must be born

John 3:2-3 (ESV) This man came to Jesus by night and said to him, "Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher come from God, for no one can do these signs that you do unless God is with him." Jesus answered him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God."

John 3:4-5 (ESV) Nicodemus said to him, "How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?" Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.

John 3:7-8 (ESV) Do not marvel that I said to you, 'You must be born again.' The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear its sound, but you do not know where it comes from or where it goes. So it is with everyone who is born of the Spirit."

2. You must _____ the truth

John 3:9 (ESV) Nicodemus said to him, "How can these things be?"

John 3:11b-12 (ESV) ... but you do not receive our testimony. If I have told you earthly things and you do not believe, how can you believe if I tell you heavenly things?

3. You must in Jesus				
John 3:14-15 (ESV) And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, that whoever believes in him may have eternal life.				
John 3:16 (ESV) "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, tha whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.				
4. Believers in Jesus are not				
John 3:18 (ESV) Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God.				
John 3:19-20 (ESV) And this is the judgment: the light has come into the world, and people loved the darkness rather than the light because their work were evil. For everyone who does wicked things hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his works should be exposed.				
John 3:21 (ESV) But whoever does what is true comes to the light, so that it may be clearly seen that his works have been carried out in God."
